

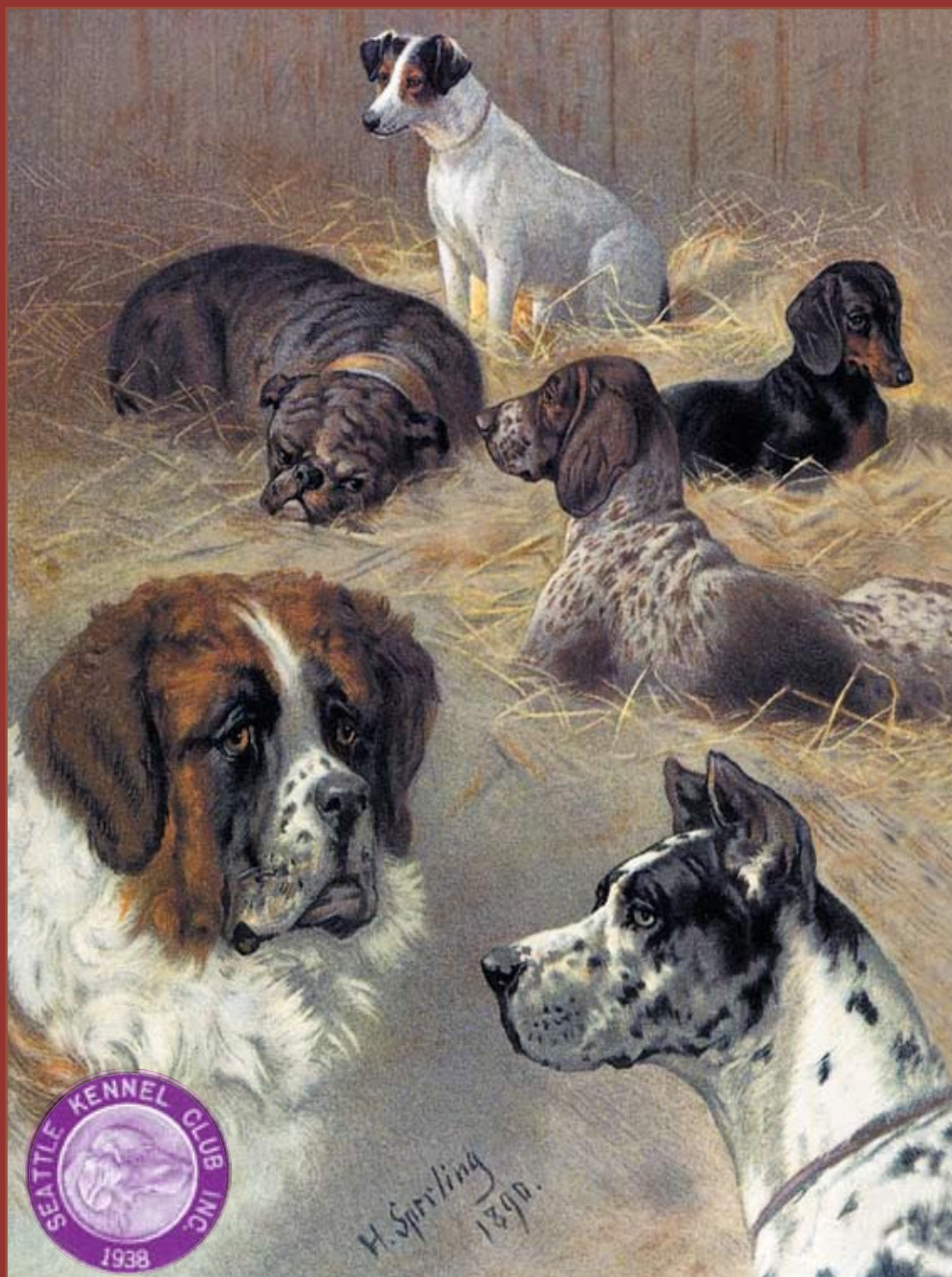

The Seven Groups in All-Breed Shows

Sporting – These dogs were bred to hunt game birds both on land and in the water. The breeds in this group include Pointers, Retrievers, Setters and Spaniels.

Hounds – These breeds were bred for hunting other game by sight or scent. These breeds include such dogs as Beagles, Bassets, Dachshunds and Greyhounds.

Working – These dogs were bred to pull carts, guard property and perform search and rescue services. Among the breeds in this group are the Akita, Boxer, Doberman Pinscher and St. Bernard.

Terrier – This group includes breeds such as the Airedale, Cairn Terrier and Scottish Terrier. Terriers were bred to rid property of vermin such as rats.

Toy – These dogs were bred to be household companions. This group includes little dogs such as the Chihuahua, Maltese, Pomeranian and Pug.

Non-Sporting – This diverse group includes the Chow Chow, Bulldog, Dalmatian and Poodle. These dogs vary in size and function, and many are considered companion dogs.

Herding – These dogs were bred to help shepherds and ranchers herd their livestock. The Briard, Collie, German Shepherd Dog and Old English Sheepdog are some of the breeds in this group.

AKC Inspects!

The AKC is the only purebred registry in the United States with an ongoing routine kennel inspection program. The AKC has a dedicated team of field inspectors who visit kennels to ensure the proper care and conditions of AKC-registered dogs and verify that breeders are maintaining accurate records for their dogs. In 2007, AKC field inspectors conducted approximately 5,600 inspections nationwide. The AKC dedicates nearly \$6 million annually to its compliance programs to ensure the accuracy of its registry and the care and conditions of dogs raised by breeders of AKC dogs.

Dog Show Terms

Baiting - Using liver or some treat to get the dog's attention and have him look alert.

Exhibitor - A person who brings a dog to a dog show and shows it in the appropriate class.

Fancier - A person who is especially interested, and usually active, in some phase of the sport of purebred dogs.

Gait - The way a dog moves, movement is a good indicator of structure and condition.

Handler - A person or agent who takes a dog into the show ring or who works the dog at a field trial or other performance event.

Heel - A command to a dog to keep close beside its handler.

Pedigree - The written record of a dog's family tree of three or more generations.

Stacking - Posing the dog to create a pleasing picture.

HOW DOGS ARE JUDGED

CLASSES – In every breed, dogs (Males) are judged first, then bitches (Females). For each sex there are six classes: 1. PUPPY for dogs between 6 months and under one year of age; 2. 12 MONTHS & UNDER 18 for dogs between 12 months and under 18 months of age; 3. NOVICE for dogs which have never won a first prize; 4. AMATEUR-OWNER-HANDLER for exhibitors who are not professional handlers or judges; 4. BRED BY EXHIBITOR for dogs presently owned and exhibited by the same person or kennel who were recognized breeders on the records of the American Kennel Club; 5. AMERICAN BRED for dogs born in the U.S.A.; 6. OPEN for all dogs American and foreign bred. Usually the most experienced show dogs are to be seen in the American Bred and Open Classes.

WINNERS – Into this competition come the first prize winners of the above classes, and two awards are made: WINNERS (purple ribbon) and RESERVE WINNERS (purple and white ribbon).

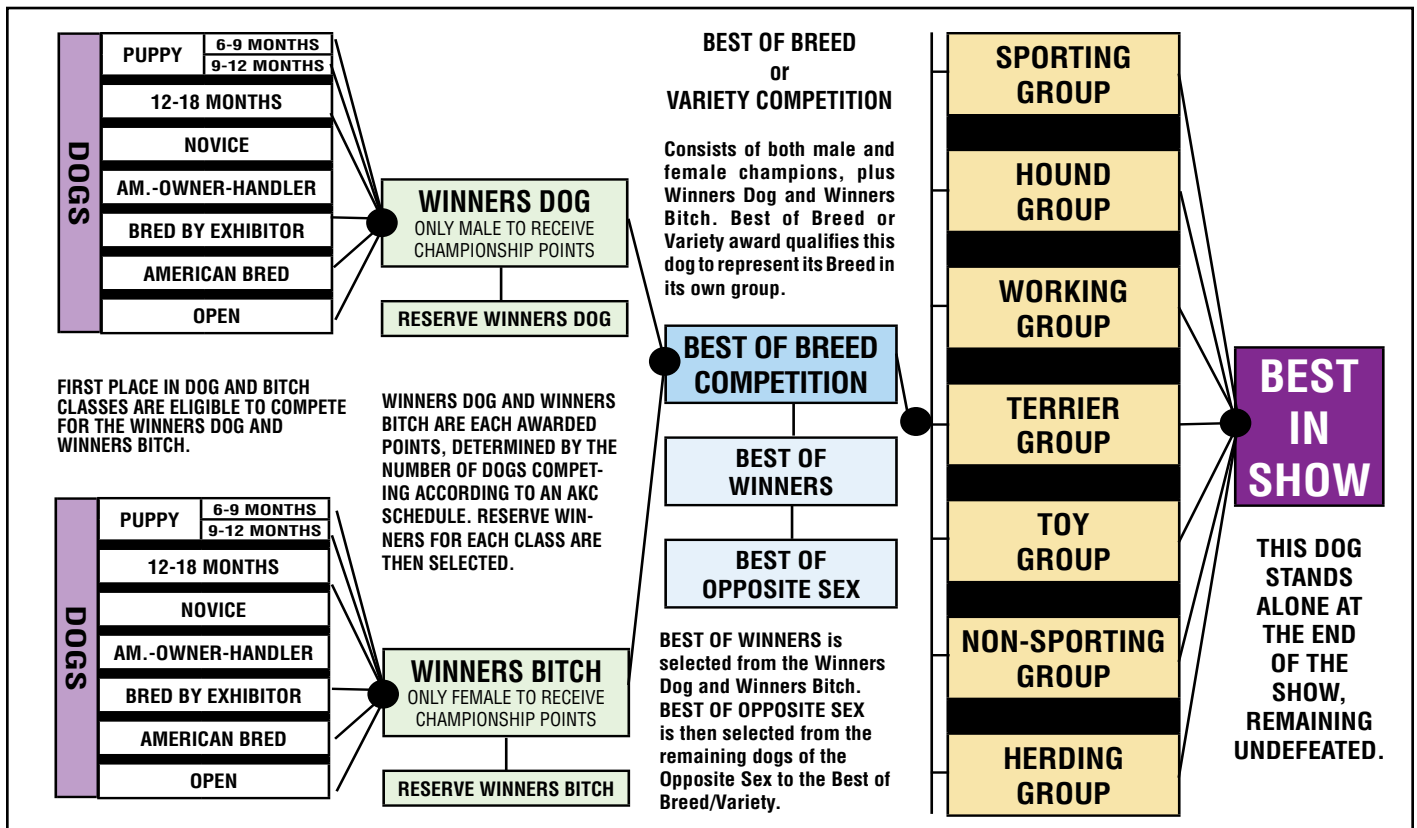
BEST OF BREED COMPETITION – Dogs of either sex which are already Champions and the two which were chosen Winners compete here and one is chosen BEST OF BREED. This dog competes later in the Groups as sole representative of his breed.

BEST OF WINNERS – Only two dogs compete in this class – the Winners Dog and the Winners Bitch. One is chosen BEST OF WINNERS.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS – Championship points can be won by one dog and one bitch in each breed. The Winners Dog and Winners Bitch receive these points. The number of points depends on the number of each sex competing in each breed. When a dog has received 15 points he is a Champion and holds the title all his life.

WHAT A JUDGE JUDGES ON – As a judge goes over each dog in the ring he is comparing him to a mental picture of the perfect dog of that breed. He judges each dog on: 1. Physical structure (head, teeth, feet, bone structure, muscle tone, etc.); 2. Condition (proper weight, condition of coat, animation, etc.) 3. Gait as seen from front, side and rear. 4. Temperament penalizing heavily for shyness or viciousness.

THE END OF THE SHOW – In a dog show the competition becomes keener and more exciting at the end. When all breeds have been judged, only one dog in each breed remains undefeated the one which was chosen Best of Breed. These dogs are called to compete in one of the seven groups Sporting, Hound, Working, Terrier, Toy, Non-Sporting, and Herding. One wins each group. These seven GROUP WINNERS meet in the final competition and one is chosen BEST IN SHOW. This dog stands alone at the end of the show, remaining undefeated.

AKC EVENTS AT THESE SHOWS

Conformation RINGS 1-11

Dog shows, or "conformation" events, are the signature events of the AKC. Exhibits are judged against breed standards, which have been established for the AKC-recognized breeds by their parent clubs. These written standards describe the ideal size, color, and temperament of each breed, as well as correct proportion, structure, and movement.

Obedience RINGS 21-22

Obedience Trials test a dog's ability to perform a prescribed set of exercises on which it is scored. In each exercise, the dog must score more than 50% of the possible points and get a total score of at least 170 out of a possible 200. Each time the dog gets that magic 170 qualifying score, he's earned a "leg" towards his title. Three legs and the dog has become an Obedience Titled dog! There are 3 levels at which a dog can earn a title and each is more difficult than the one before it.

Rally RING 23

Rally is a sport in which the dog and handler compete through a course of designated stations. Rally provides a link from the Canine Good Citizen® (CGC) program to obedience or agility competition, both for dogs and handlers. In addition, rally promotes fun and enjoyment for dogs at all levels of competition.

Agility RING 31

Agility is the ultimate game for you and your dog. It is also one of the most exciting canine sports for spectators. In agility, a dog demonstrates its agile nature and versatility by following cues from the handler through a timed obstacle course. The course has jumps, tunnels, weave poles, and other obstacles. Agility strengthens the bond between dogs and handlers, it is extremely fun, and it provides vigorous exercise for both!

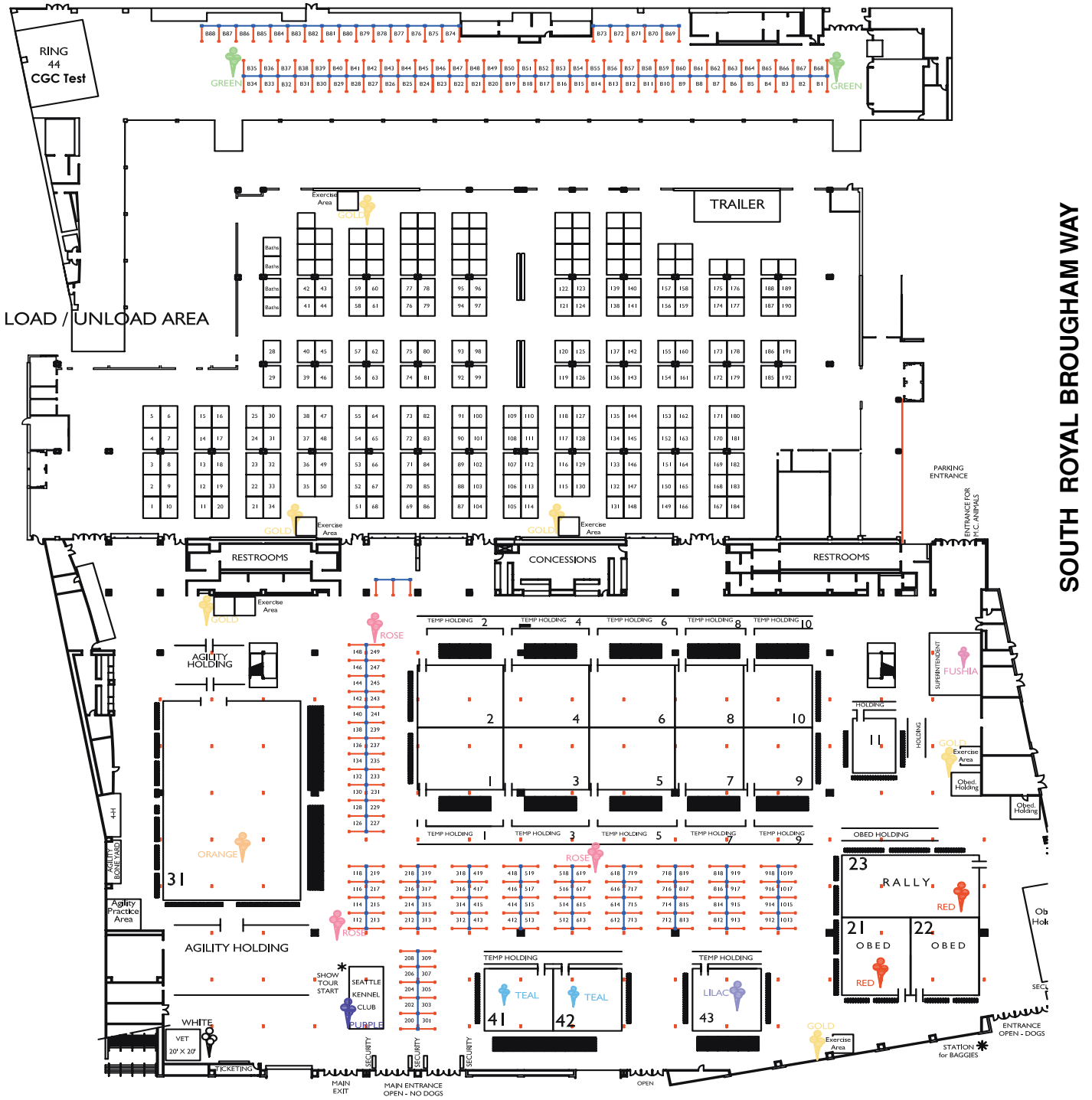
